


Using PSTricks with pdflatex on Overleaf

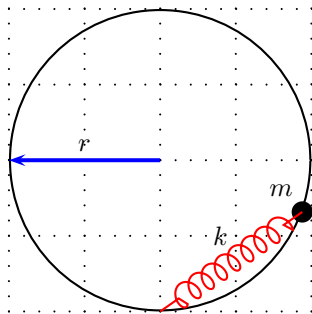

Solution 1: Compile with XeLaTeX. You can switch to XeLaTeX by clicking on the Settings  icon on the upper right of the editor.

Solution 2: Use `auto-pst-pdf` together with a custom `latexmkrc` file. You can look in this file to copy the lines in it, by loading it from the file list. (If you don't see a file list in your Overleaf editor, click on the **PROJECT** link in the top bar first.)
