Solution 1 (Recommended): Compile with XeLaTeX. You can switch to XeLaTeX from the Overleaf project: see this help page too.

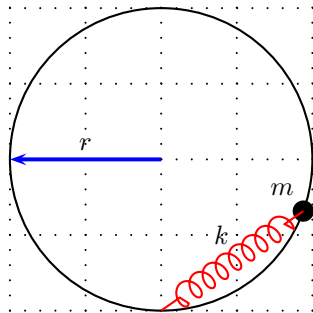
Solution 2: Use the `auto-pst-pdf` package **together with** a custom `latexmkrc` file that contains this line:

```
$hash_calc_ignore_pattern{'pdf'} = '^/(CreationDate|ModDate|ID) ';
```

You will also need to add this line before your `\documentclass`:

```
\def\jobname{main} % or whatever your main document .tex file is named!
```
