**Solution 1 (Recommended):** Compile with XeLaTeX. You can switch to XeLaTeX from the Overlef project: see this help page too.


Solution 2: Use the auto-pst-pdf package together with a custom latexmkrc file that contains this line:

\$hash\_calc\_ignore\_pattern{'pdf'} = '^/(CreationDate|ModDate|ID) ';

You will also need to add this line before your \documentclass:

\def\jobname{main} % or whatever your main document .tex file is named!
