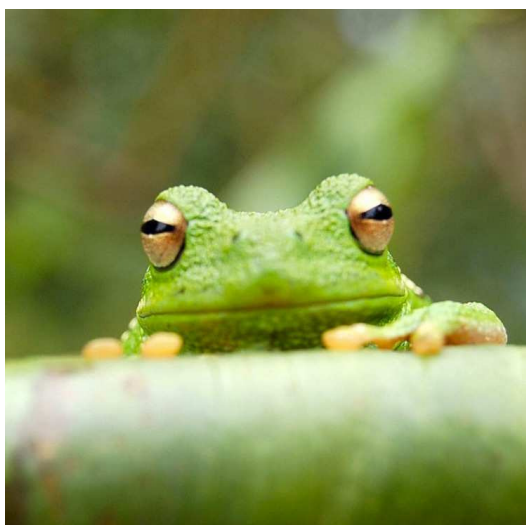


Fig. 1. Placeholder image of a frog with a long example caption to show justification setting.

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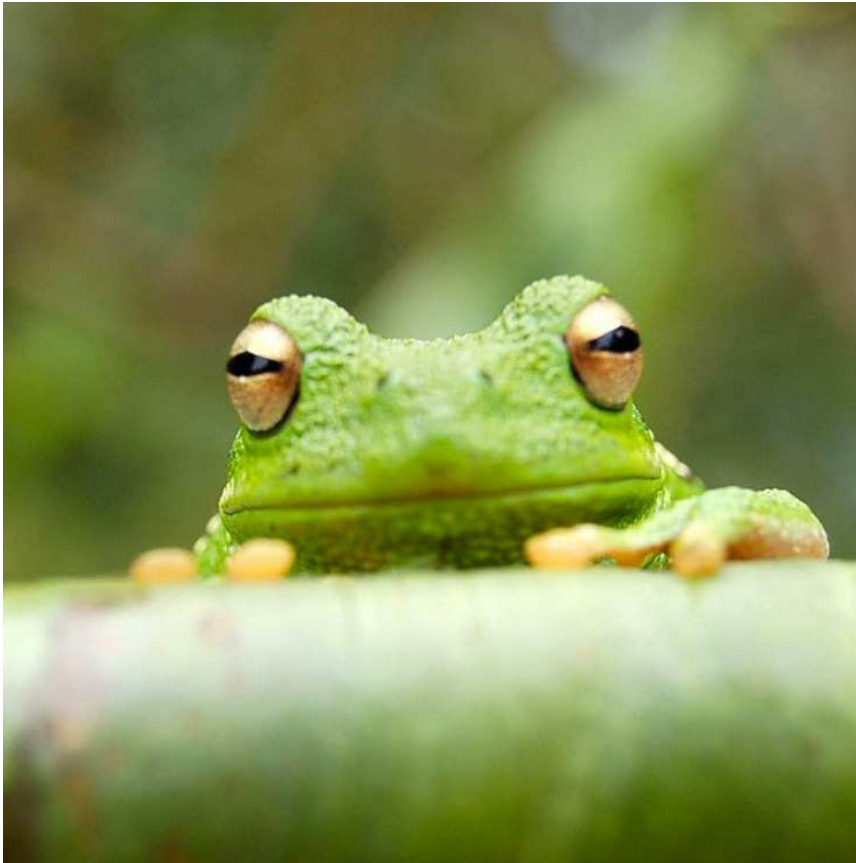


Fig. 2. This caption would be placed at the side of the figure, rather than below it.
